

The following brief presentations provide information about making and submitting child outcome ratings information to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment and the Kansas State Department of Education. State lead agencies for Part C and Part B are required by IDEA 2004 to collect and submit this data to the office of Special Education Programs as part of the State Performance Plan and Annual Performance Reports.

Materials selected for inclusion in this series of presentations is an effort to respond to current challenges of the timely submissions of valid and reliable data by Part B and Part C organizations in Kansas.

Challenges were identified through data analysis of the data submitted through the outcomes web system application and information gathered in pilot study activities conducted in Kansas.

The material presented is designed to help personnel with experience in making child outcome ratings to improve the rating process and timely submission of data. The presentations can be used as a quick review of the information presented Revisiting Early Childhood Outcomes Regional Training provided in 2007 and 2008.
